The School of Teacher Education at National Taiwan Normal University (NTNU) is pleased to announce the International Conference on " Teacher Preparation for Bilingual Subject Instruction: Development, Implementation, and Reflection," scheduled for October 26-27, 2024 (Sat. and Sun.). The conference will feature keynote speeches, panel forums, paper presentations, and subject area workshops.

Paper presentations will be conducted through both invited and open submissions to enhance the academic theory and practice of bilingual teacher preparation in Taiwan.

III. Abstract Submission

- Papers must include abstracts in both Chinese and English. The Chinese abstract should not exceed 450 characters, and the English abstract should not exceed 250 words. Please include 3-5 keywords.
- 2. Research overview: Should include backgrounds, research methods, findings and discussion, and conclusions, up to 1000 words.
- 3. Content requirements: Only unpublished papers will be accepted. Please combine the Chinese and English abstracts and the research overview into a single PDF.
- 4. Submit the abstract before August 15th, 2024. The review result will be notified on September 2nd, 2024.
